SUBJECT: BEAUDOIN, Gerald, British subject, AIC 1081

TO : AC of S, G-2, Third United States Army, APO 403

1. Details of Arrest. BEAUDOIN was arrested in PLZEN on 21 May 1945 by CIC Detachment 205 after he had been denounced by the Czech secret police as a possible agent for GERMANY. He arrived at Third US Army Intelligence Center on 24 May 1945.

2. Summary of Interrogation. BEAUDOIN is 25 years old and was born in MONTREAL, Canada. After infantry training and service in NEW FOUNDLAND, BRITISH COLUMBIA and LIVERPOOL, he arrived in FRANCE in July 1944. BEAUDOIN was captured by the Germans at ST MARTIN on 25 July 1945. He was held in Stalags XII A and VIII B until January 27, 1945. He escaped from Stalag VIII B in TESCHEN, when the Russian advance was imminent and worked for Czech farmers in NOVY BYDZOV until the end of the war. BEAUDOIN had represented himself to a girlfriend, Marie STARA, as an RAF officer. For that reason alone, he claims, he adhered to his story in subsequent interrogations held in her presence.

3. Disposition. Subject denies having been an agent for the Germans. He is to be evacuated through M G channels and delivered to British authorities.
