# Visiting the Museum and the Site of National Remembrance in Łambinowice

#### Admission and opening times

Admission is free for all visitors from Tuesday till Sunday. The Museum is closed on Mondays.

The museum is open for visitors: From 1 October to 30 April: Tuesday - Friday: 9.00 - 16.00

Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays: 10.00 - 17.00

From 1 May to 30 September: Tuesday - Friday: 9.00 - 17.00

Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays: 10.00 - 17.00

Please note that free admission is for self-guided tours. You don't need to book a time for your visit. However if a guided tour is required we have following options available.

Organized Groups

Group visits are available at reduced rates for a minimum of fifteen people. Booking must be made by phone or by email at least two weeks in advance. Visitors often request a museum tour for fewer than fifteen people. The museum is pleased to offer personal guided tours of the exhibitions and the Site of National Remembrance for individuals or small groups. Personal tours are conducted from Tuesday till Friday from 8.00 a.m to 15.30 p.m.

Please note that during public holidays and on Saturdays and Sundays the quide service is not available. You are welcome to visit our museum for self-guided tour then. The admission is free. Booking is not required. \* Please note the museum is closed for visitors on Mondays. \* In order to visit the Site of National Remembrance a vehicle is required. If you have not got your own, you can rent a bike or the car with driver in the museum (after prior notification of 7 days). The fee for renting a bike is 3 ZL, the car - 40 ZL per person. The museum is open daily from 8.00 - 15.00 (except Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays) You will find there interesting exhibitions. The Museum is located at Minorytów Street no.3, 45-017 Opole.
